Award half of the allotted marks for each criteria that needs improvement. Award 0 marks for each criteria that does not meet the stated expectations.</i></p>	1
	<p><b><u>Organisation</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Includes all components of a formal letter (date, sender and receiver addresses, subject line, opening and closing salutations) and follows the correct format for a formal letter (date in expanded form, alignment of content, paragraph breaks) [0.50 marks]</li> <li>◆ Provides a clear sense of a beginning, middle and end and a smooth transition of ideas [0.50 marks]</li> </ul> <p><i>Award the full allotted marks for each criteria that meets the stated expectations. Award half of the allotted marks for each criteria that needs improvement. Award 0 marks for each criteria that does not meet the stated expectations.</i></p>	1
	<p><b><u>Language Mechanics</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Uses correct grammar, spelling and other language mechanics</li> </ul> <p><i>Award the full allotted marks if there are only one or two minor errors. Award half of the allotted marks if there is one major error. Award 0 marks if there is more than one major error.</i></p>	1

	<p><b><u>Language Mechanics</u></b></p> <p>◆ Uses correct grammar, spelling and other language mechanics</p> <p><i>Award the full allotted marks if there are only one or two minor errors. Award half of the allotted marks if there is one major error. Award 0 marks if there is more than one major error.</i></p>	0.5
23	<p><b>Sample Answer: Bheema may have carried heavy clothes for Ramu, the washerman.</b></p>	0
	<p><b><u>Content</u></b></p> <p>◆ States what work Bheema most likely did for Ramu</p> <p>(Bheema may have carried loads for Ramu/Bheema may have helped Ramu in carrying heavy things)</p> <p><i>Accept any other valid answer supported by the story.</i></p>	1
24	<p><b>Sample Answer: All the animals that Bheema spoke to were very helpful.</b></p>	0
	<p><b><u>Content</u></b></p> <p>◆ Describes a common feature of all the animals Bheema spoke to</p> <p>(all the animals were very helpful/all the animals were kind and agreed to help him/all the animals were friendly and agreed to help him)</p> <p><i>Accept any other valid response supported by the story.</i></p>	1
25	<p><b>Sample Answer: Bheema must have felt surprised and happy to wake up early when he awoke with a sneeze.</b></p>	0



Q.No	What to look for	Marks
	<p><b><u>Content</u></b></p> <p>♦ States how Bheema must have felt when he woke up sneezing (he must have felt shocked/he must have felt surprised/he must have been amazed)</p> <p><i>Accept any other valid answer supported by the story.</i></p>	1
26	<p><b>Sample Answer: At the end of the story, Bheema was helped by the fly and he was happy that he could now wake up early to help Ramu, the washerman.</b></p>	0
	<p><b><u>Content</u></b></p> <p>♦ Describes the ending of the story (Bheema was happy/Bheema could now wake up early/Bheema was helped by the fly and he could wake up early)</p> <p><i>Accept any other valid response supported by the story.</i></p>	1
27	<p><b>Sample Answer: often</b></p>	0
	<p><b><u>Content</u></b></p> <p>♦ Identifies and writes the word from paragraph 1 that means 'frequently' (often)</p>	1
