


- 1. The table below gives the correct answer for each multiple-choice question in this test across version 1. All 4 versions have the same order of questions, hence this can be used for other versions too.
- 2. If you are evaluating these questions on paper, please award the student 1 mark for choosing the right option for each question.





	(quick and easy cutting of the door)	
	Accept any other valid response supported by the story.

26	Sample Answer: The speaker was treated with a certain level of importance probably because he was a scientist and his experiment was valued by the ants.	0
	<u>Content</u>	1
	♦ Mentions the probable reason for the importance given to the speaker	
	(he was a scientist/his experiment was valued by the ants/the ants used to treat their prisoners nicely)	
	Accept any other valid response supported by the story.	
27	Sample Answer : The ants in the story are shown to be very authoritative.	0
	<u>Content</u>	1
	♦ States one trait for the ants	
	(authoritative/strong/dominating/hardworking)	
	Accept any other valid response supported by the story.
