HAPS boarding school gives children a very special experience. The daily routine and the communal living they experience at an early age help them learn self discipline and self reliance.

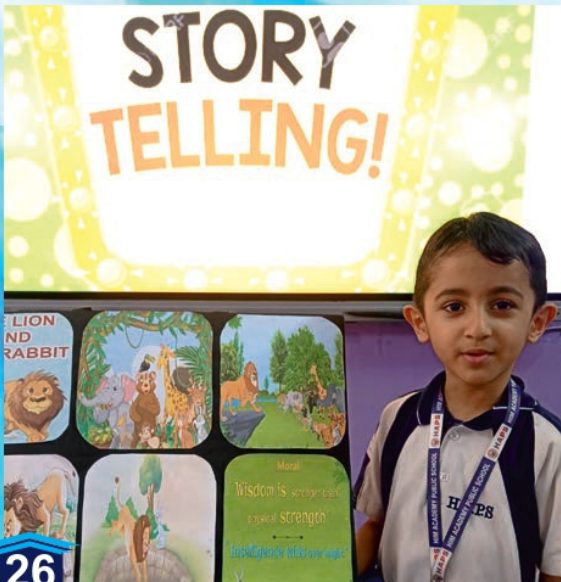
